

Learning and Development

Training, learning and development opportunities for involvement exist for public contributors, researchers and public involvement managers. Despite this, it remains an area in need of better support and coordination. This was highlighted in 2015, when both the Going the Extra Mile report and an NIHR-wide Learning & Development Working Group report were published.

In December 2016, INVOLVE established a Learning and Development Project Group to address better coordination, improved methods of identifying individuals' learning and development needs, and to improve access to existing opportunities.
